#### **ROSH HASHONOH 5774**

What have the years 1785, 1842,1861 and 1899 in common? They were the last years when the first day of Rosh Hashonoh fell on 5<sup>th</sup> September. Previous to 1785, the earliest first day of Rosh Hashonoh was 4<sup>th</sup> September 1766. The next occasion that Rosh Hashonoh will be on 5<sup>th</sup> September will be in 2089, assuming we still have a fixed calendar.
