Yom Ha'atzmaut Before and Beyond

We are all keen to celebrate Yom Ha'atzmaut but we should also remember what else happened at that time. We recall just one episode out of many. Jaffa was a key Arab town overlooking Tel Aviv. The Egyptians could enter from the sea and Arab snipers could fire at Tel Aviv. The Haganah devised a plan (named operation Hametz) to capture Jaffa by capturing the surrounding villages, to begin on the first day of Pesach. The Irgun doubted whether the plan would succeed as Egypt could still enter by sea and they planned a frontal assault on the city which they launched on the first day of Chol Hamoed with 600 fighters. However they met strong resistance and suffered many casualties and on the second day Menachem Begin, head of the Irgun, ordered a retreat. The front line fighters refused and they succeeded to win the city. However the British began bombarding the Irgun fighters with tanks and artillery. The Irgun managed to disable the tanks with explosives and Molotov cocktails and the British gave up and many Arabs then fled. Forty one Irgun fighters fell (over half to the British) and over seventy five were wounded. For them, and others, the period is marked by Yom Hazikaron and Yom Ha'atzmaut.
