Mr Lubashevsky was a survivor of the Milchemet Hashichrur (the War of Independence) and, for many years, the Ba'al Tekiah of the Shul. He also was behind the publication of Haggodos with Russian, Hungarian and Amharic translations. An article on these Haggodos appeared in the Shul Magazine some years ago
