LATEST TIME FOR SHEMA***

Members will have noted that on our bi-annual publications, the Magazine and Timetables, two separate "Latest Times" are shown for Shema. In the words of the late Rav Cooper זצ"ל, ideally one should try to say Shema before the "Earlier" time (this week **8.26am**) and use the "Later" time (this week **9.12am**) if one has overslept or in an emergency.

CHILDREN'S SERVICE (cS)

The Children's service, under the management of David Foskett, commences in the Beis Hamedrash Toras Haim at the new time of 10.30am. All children in Y1 and above are welcome. cS has been revamped with new ideas. If you wish to become involved in cS, please speak to David Foskett.

CHILDREN'S KIDDUSH

The Children's Kiddush commences after Kedusha in Mussaf. There will be Kiddush, D'var Torah and nosh. cK is run by Raffis Maurer and Rabinowitz.

PREPARATIONS FOR TISHA B'AV

The Hafsokoh at 8.54pm on Shabbos is the time when eating must cease before the fast. The restriction of not wearing shoes applies only after Shabbos. Members are reminded to bring their Tisha B'Av shoes and Kinnos to Shul before Shabbos as one may not wear Tisha B'Av shoes on Shabbos nor may one prepare on Shabbos for Motzoi Shabbos..

HAVDOLAH AFTER TISHA B'AV

After Shabbos this week, since there is no Havdolah, Ladies in particular, should say "Hamavdil Bein Kodesh Lechol" and "Borei Meoray Ha'esh" before doing any work (Gentlemen say "Ato Chonantonu" in Maariv) Please remember to make Havdolah after the Fast, without a Havdolah candle or Besomim, but commencing with "Boray Pri Hagofen" followed by "Boruch..... Hamavdil". The person saying Havdolah only, should drink all the wine/grape juice. A child under Bar/Bas Mitzvah need not be given the wine to drink as an alternative. Anyone who has to eat or drink on the fast for health reasons must make Havdolah before eating in the way detailed above on pure fruit juice i.e not from concentrate or beer.

RESTRICTIONS AFTER TISHA B'AV

Since this year Tisha B'av is "Nidche" i.e. delayed from Shabbos, the usual 9 day restrictions do not apply this year after the fast, except for not eating meat and drinking wine that evening. Therefore, for instance, all washing, showering and laundry way be commenced immediately after the fast.
