### SAYING KADDISH IN SHUL

Rabbi Ephraim Zalman Margulies, author of the "Mattei Ephraim" writes in his pamphlet "Pesach Hasha'ar" on the dinim of Kaddish as follows: "One should be particular to say Kaddish in a loud voice so that at least nine other persons can hear him and answer appropriately. Someone who says Kaddish quietly i.e. where not sufficient people can answer, is called a thief for he has robbed others of the opportunity of saying 'Yehai Shemai Rabboh' Amen, etc. .We would therefore respectfully request anyone saying Kaddish to comply with this requirement. Anyone saying Kaddish for a relative, other than a direct relative, who is not certain whether they should be saying Kaddish at all, or how many Kaddishes they should say, is welcome to discuss this matter with the Rav. *The Mishna Berura (55-4) add a very interesting comment on this subject "Whether someone created through Sefer Yetzirah (i.e. a "Golem") can be included in a Minyan, see Chacham Zvi Siman 63.*
