### BEWARE! NEW CREDIT/DEBIT CARD SCAM

The latest scam, which has already hit a relative of two of our members, is that the person will receive a call from someone who is making out that they are speaking from their bank, to advise them that there is a problem with their debit card and that the bank will send a courier to collect the card for further investigation. Naturally, this is a scam from fraudsters who want to get hold of the card.

Please make relatives, especially older people, aware of this. Debit, or credit cards, should never leave the sight of the card holder, as the card can be cloned when it is out of sight, especially in restaurants.
