I shall allow him or any other person duly authorised by him, to inspect or remove the goods at any time.”

SALE OF CHOMETZ ARRANGEMENTS 2021/5781

The Sale of Chometz will take place in person in the Shul Beis Hamedrash on Sunday 21 March, Tuesday 23 March or Wednesday 24 March 8.00pm to 9.00pm MASKS MUST BE WORN AND FULL SOCIAL DISTANCING WILL APPLY. This is the preferred Halachik form of sale, making a Kinyan to appoint the Rav to sell on your behalf.

However, anyone preferring, for Covid-19 reasons, may post this completed schedule, signed by proxy, into the letter box of the Rav’s office (left hand side door at 33 Boyne Avenue London NW4 2JL If this is not possible, send it by 1st class mail in good time to this address. Mark the envelope “Sale of Chometz” and check by phone with the Rav that he has received the form.
