HOSHANOH RABBOH SHACHARIS

In response to requests from members, there will be an early Minyan for Shacharis which will commence at **7.00**am and will take place in the Beis Hamedrash Toras Haim. The regular Minyan will commence at 8.00am

HOSHANOH RABBOH

Hoshanoh Rabboh is known as the last of the Days of Judgment which began on Rosh Hashonoh. The Zohar says that while the judgment for the new year is sealed on Yom Kippur it is not "delivered" until the end of Succos (i.e., Hoshanoh Rabboh), during which time one can still alter their verdict and decree for the new year. Consequently, the blessing which Jews give each other on Hoshana Rabbah, אבט אקתפ (piska tova), and in Yiddish "A guten kvitel", or "A good note", is a wish that the verdict will be positive. We have the custom to lein the whole of Sefer Devorim.
